

Sure, it was an accident. But the blaze killed his mom and set his dad on a path to self-destruction. Everything else about that fateful night is full of gaping holes in Theo's mind, for good reason. Maybe it's better that way. As captain of the Ellis Hollow Diving Team, with straight A's and solid friends, he's only one semester away from securing a scholarship and leaving his past behind.

But when a family history project gets assigned at school, new memories come rushing to the surface, memories that make Theo question what he really knows about his family, the night of the fire, and if he can trust anyone—including himself.

Discussion Guide

- 1. Theo holds himself to a very high standard on and off the diving board. Did that help or hinder him from uncovering the mystery surrounding his mother's death?
- 2. Springboard Diving plays a huge role in *Dive Smack*. In what ways do you think the plot of this book is similar to a complicated dive?
- 3. Iris Fiorello is the girl of Theo's dreams. How was Iris's life similar to Theo's?
- 4. Theo and Chip have an amazing friendship full of support in humor. What about Chip's role in Theo's life helped him learn the truth about his family?
- 5. Theo's grandfather withheld information from Theo about his parents and uncle. How would you feel about a family member keeping secrets from you?
- Theo can be unkind to Les Carter early on in the novel. What role did his suppositions about Les play in holding Theo back from his own goals.
- 7. There are some scary diving moments in *Dive Smack*. Did you fear for Theo's life at any point in the novel?
- 8. The author dropped several hints and breadcrumbs about what was coming throughout the first two-thirds of the novel. Did you guess what happened to Theo's mother or did it come as a surprise?
- 9. Uncle Phil is not who he pretends to be. What clues do you think Theo missed about his uncle and why?
- 10. Iris Fiorello is clear that people find themselves put into social boxes based on other people's false ideas and views. How did Theo change those boundaries in *Dive Smack*?
